WHAT IS THE TEST ADMINISTRATOR CERTIFICATION?

This is a very practical course that provides delegates with the necessary skills to ensure ability and/or personality tests are properly administered. This can be considered as a stepping stone to achieving the BPS Level A qualification. Please see our Level A brochure for more information.

The training covers some of the fundamentals of using psychometrics, including equal opportunities and the skills necessary to administer and score ability and/or personality tests.

SUMMARY OF LEVEL A AND B

Level A

Level A is the first step in the British Psychological Society's accreditation process. The training focuses on ability tests and covers the fundamentals in using psychometrics.

Level B

Level B is the next step in the accreditation process. It focuses on personality tests and builds on what you have learned in Level A. You will specialise in one specific personality measure, which can be the 15FQ+ or the Baron EQ-i ®, and this will allow you to purchase and use a number of other tests.

Level B Intermediate Plus

This is the next step up for those who have attained the Level B qualification. The training will focus on furthering your psychometric expertise via an additional personality inventory, the 15FQ+ or the BarOn EQ-i ® personality questionnaire (depending upon which tool you specialised in for your Level B Intermediate).

Level B Full

This is the BPS' highest level of certification. This is designed for those in search of a deeper understanding of the issues involved in personality assessment and test construction.

ONLINE LEARNING BENEFITS

Online learning generally takes 25 hours for Level A and 15 hours for Level B.
